1	AN ACT to amend 945.03 (intro.) and 945.04 (intro.) of the statutes; relating to:
2	reducing the penalty for certain gambling offenses and providing a penalty.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 945.03 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	945.03 Commercial gambling. (intro.) Whoever intentionally does any of
5	the following is engaged in commercial gambling and is guilty of a Class \pm felony <u>C</u>
6	misdemeanor:
7	SECTION 2. 945.04 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	945.04 Permitting premises to be used for commercial gambling.
9	(intro.) Whoever intentionally does any of the following is guilty of a Class A \underline{C}
10	misdemeanor:
11	SECTION 3. Initial applicability.
12	(1) This act first applies to offenses committed on or after the effective date of
13	this subsection.
