



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 814**

February 15, 1996 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 5.15 (2) (b) 3. and 5.15 (2) (b) 4.; and **to create** 5.15 (2) (b) 5.  
2             of the statutes; **relating to:** minimum population requirements for wards in  
3             certain municipalities.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4             **SECTION 1.** 5.15 (2) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

5             5.15 (2) (b) 3. In any city, village or town in which the population is at least  
6             10,000 but less than 39,000, each ward shall contain not less than ~~600~~ 300 nor more  
7             than 2,100 inhabitants.

8             **SECTION 2.** 5.15 (2) (b) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

9             5.15 (2) (b) 4. In any city, village or town in which the population is less than  
10            10,000, if any portion of the city or village is located in, or if the town is located in,  
11            a county having a population of 25,000 or more, each ward shall contain not less than  
12            ~~300~~ 200 nor more than 1,000 inhabitants.
