SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 91

June 1, 1995 – Offered by Committee on Transportation, Agriculture and Local Affairs.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 1, line 3: before the period insert: "and of flashing warning lamps on authorized emergency vehicles".
 - **2.** Page 2, line 10: after that line, delete the material inserted by assembly amendment 2 and substitute:

"Section 1m. 347.25 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

347.25 (5) Notwithstanding s. 347.26 (11), whenever flashing warning lamps on an authorized emergency vehicle are designed and being used to exhibit a directional arrow at the scene of an emergency, all such lamps exhibiting the directional arrow shall be flashing simultaneously. If the use of flashing warning lamps to exhibit a directional arrow would likely direct approaching traffic into a lane of traffic moving in the opposite direction, only the flashing warning lamps that exhibit the horizontal bar of a directional arrow may be used and such lamps shall be flashing simultaneously."
