



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 15,
TO 1995 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 2**

January 4, 1995 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the resolution as follows:

2 **1.** Page 15, line 13: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 32m.** Assembly rule 26 (6) is created to read:

4 Assembly Rule 26 (6) No person may use a long-range electronic, mechanical
5 or other device to intercept a conversation within the chambers without the consent
6 of the assembly pursuant to a resolution specifying the dates and times that the
7 interception is allowed. No person may broadcast or otherwise disclose such a
8 conversation intercepted by a long-range electronic, mechanical or other device
9 without the consent of the assembly pursuant to a resolution. This subsection does
10 not prohibit the recording or broadcast of the proceedings of the assembly or of an
11 interview conducted with the consent of the person interviewed.”.
