



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 378**

February 28, 1996 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON INSURANCE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “insurance” insert: “and providing occurrence or
3 claims-made coverage”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 20: delete that line and substitute:

5 “655.23 (4) ~~Health care liability insurance, self-insurance~~ Self-insurance or
6 a cash or surety”.

7 **3.** Page 3, line 7: after that line insert:

8 “**SECTION 3.** 655.23 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:

9 655.23 (4m) Before July 1, 1996, health care liability insurance may have
10 provided occurrence or claims-made coverage and shall have been in amounts of at
11 least \$200,000 for each occurrence or claim and \$600,000 per year for all occurrences
12 in any one policy year or all claims in any one reporting year for occurrences or claims
13 before July 1, 1987, \$300,000 for each occurrence or claim and \$900,000 for all
14 occurrences in any one policy year or all claims in any one reporting year for
15 occurrences or claims on or after July 1, 1987 and before July 1, 1988, and \$400,000
16 for each occurrence or claim and \$1,000,000 for all occurrences in any one policy year

1 or all claims in any one reporting year for occurrences or claims on or after July 1,
2 1988, and before July 1, 1996. On and after July 1, 1996, health care liability
3 insurance may provide occurrence or claims-made coverage and shall be in amounts
4 of at least \$1,000,000 for each occurrence or claim and \$3,000,000 for all occurrences
5 in any one policy year or all claims in any one reporting year for occurrences or claims
6 on or after July 1, 1996.

7 **SECTION 4. Effective date.**

8 (1) This act takes effect on July 1, 1996.”.
