



**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 89**

March 9, 1995 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND ENERGY.

1     **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 144.3716 (1); *to amend* 144.3716 (3) (a); and  
2           *to create* 144.3716 (1) (b) and 144.3716 (3) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** the  
3           sale and purchase of reformulated gasoline containing methyl tertiary butyl  
4           ether or ethyl tertiary butyl ether.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

5           **SECTION 1.** 144.3716 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 144.3716 (1) (intro.) and  
6           amended to read:

7           144.3716 (1) DEFINITIONS. (intro.) In this section, ~~“reformulated;~~  
8           (a) “Reformulated gasoline” means gasoline formulated to reduce emissions of  
9           volatile organic compounds and toxic air pollutants as provided in 42 USC 7545 (k)  
10          (1) to (3).

11          **SECTION 2.** 144.3716 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

12          144.3716 (1) (b) “Retail dealer” has the meaning given in s. 78.005 (13m).
