SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1995 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 7

November 7, 1995 – Offered by Committee on Judiciary.

1	<i>To create</i> section 25 of article I of the constitution; relating to: the right to keep and
2	bear arms (first consideration).
3	Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That:
4	SECTION 1. Section 25 of article I of the constitution is created to read:
5	[Article I] Section 25. Every individual has the right to keep and bear arms for
6	any lawful purpose including for security or defense, for hunting and for recreational
7	use.
8	SECTION 2. Numbering of new section. The new section "25" of article I of the
9	constitution created in this joint resolution shall be designated by the next higher
10	open whole section number in that article if, prior to or simultaneously with the
11	ratification by the people of the amendment proposed in this joint resolution, any
12	other ratified amendment has created a "section 25" of article I of the constitution
13	of this state. If several joint resolutions simultaneously create a section 25 of article
14	I, the chief of the legislative reference bureau shall determine the sequence and the
15	numbering.

1 **Be it further resolved, That** this proposed amendment be referred to the 2 legislature to be chosen at the next general election and that it be published for 3 3 months previous to the time of holding such election.
