



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1**

September 27, 1995 – Offered by Representative WILLIAMS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 13: delete that line and substitute: “subject to s. 16.705, 16.75  
3 (1) (a) 1. and 3., (b) and (c), (1m) to (5) and (8) to (10), 16.752 or 16.765.”.

4 **2.** Page 27, line 19: after “to” insert “s. 229.70 and”.

5 **3.** Page 27, line 20: delete “The” and substitute “Subject to s. 229.70, the”.

6 **4.** Page 31, line 11: delete “**Minority contracting goals.**” and substitute  
7 “**Contracting.**”.

8 **5.** Page 33, line 10: after that line insert:

9 “(7) If a vendor is not a Wisconsin producer, distributor, supplier or retailer and  
10 the district determines that the state, foreign nation or subdivision thereof in which  
11 the vendor is domiciled grants a preference to vendors domiciled in that state, nation  
12 or subdivision in making governmental purchases, the district shall give a  
13 preference over that vendor to Wisconsin producers, distributors, suppliers and  
14 retailers, if any, when awarding an order or contract. The district may enter into

1 agreements with states, foreign nations and subdivisions thereof for the purpose of  
2 implementing this subsection.

3 (8) (a) In this subsection:

4 1. “Manufactured” means mined, produced, manufactured, fabricated or  
5 assembled.

6 2. “Manufactured in the United States” means that materials are  
7 manufactured in whole or in substantial part within the United States or that the  
8 majority of the component parts thereof were manufactured in whole or in  
9 substantial part in the United States.

10 3. “Materials” means any goods, supplies, equipment or any other tangible  
11 products or materials.

12 4. “Purchase” means acquire by purchase or lease.

13 (b) When all other factors are substantially equal, the district shall purchase  
14 materials which are manufactured to the greatest extent in the United States.

15 (c) Paragraph (b) does not apply if the materials are purchased for the purpose  
16 of commercial resale or for the purpose of use in the production of goods for  
17 commercial sale. Paragraph (b) does not apply if the district determines that the  
18 foreign nation or subdivision thereof in which the vendor is domiciled does not give  
19 preference to vendors domiciled in that nation or subdivision in making  
20 governmental purchases. Paragraph (b) does not apply if the district determines  
21 that:

22 1. The materials are not manufactured in the United States in sufficient or  
23 reasonably available quantities; or
