



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 30,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1**

September 27, 1995 – Offered by Representatives COGGS and CARPENTER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 3: after the semicolon insert: “allowing a populous county to  
3 impose a ticket tax;”.

4 **2.** Page 15, line 23: after “TAX” insert “; LOCAL TICKET TAX”.

5 **3.** Page 22, line 4: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 49m.** Subchapter X of chapter 77 [precedes 77.994] of the statutes is  
7 created to read:

8 **CHAPTER 77**

9 **SUBCHAPTER X**

10 **LOCAL TICKET TAX**

11 **77.994 Imposition.** (1) A county that has a population of 500,000 or more,  
12 by resolution of the county board, may impose a tax at the rate of no more than \$2  
13 per ticket on the tickets sold at a professional baseball stadium in that county.
