**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 8,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1**

September 27, 1995 – Offered by Representative MORRIS-TATUM.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 7: after the first semicolon insert “advertising of alcohol  
3 beverages, cigarettes and tobacco products in a baseball park facility;”.

4 **2.** Page 30, line 9: after that line insert:

5 “**(3)** ADVERTISING RESTRICTED. No person may display in a baseball park facility  
6 any advertising for, or any trademark, service mark, trade name, logo or other  
7 commercial symbol of, the following products for the purposes of selling or otherwise  
8 promoting these products:

9 (a) Cigarettes, as defined in s. 139.30 (1).

10 (b) Tobacco products, as defined in s. 139.75 (12).

11 (c) Alcohol beverages, as defined in s. 125.02 (1).”.
