**SENATE AMENDMENT 16,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1**

October 5, 1995 – Offered by Senators MOORE, GEORGE, DECKER, CLAUSING and
RISSER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 34, line 22: after that line insert:

3 “(7) REVENUE-SHARING AGREEMENT, PLAYERS’ SALARY CAP OR OTHER SIGNIFICANT
4 ECONOMIC CHANGES. A district may enter into an agreement with a professional major
5 league baseball team for the lease or common ownership of baseball park facilities
6 only if the terms of the agreement require the team to pay to the district any
7 additional revenues, in an amount determined by the district, that are received by
8 the team as a result of any revenue-sharing agreement among major league
9 professional baseball teams, any cap on the salaries that may be paid to professional
10 baseball team players or any other event which results in a substantial restructuring
11 of the economic relationships among professional major league baseball teams. A
12 district shall first apply any funds received by the district under this subsection to
13 the early retirement of bonds of the district.”.
