**SENATE AMENDMENT 8,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1**

October 3, 1995 – Offered by Senators CHVALA, CLAUSING, DECKER and MOEN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 4: after the semicolon insert: “requiring a referendum;”.

3 **2.** Page 31, line 7: delete “In” and substitute “Subject to s. 229.682 (7), in”.

4 **3.** Page 34, line 22: after that line insert:

5 “(7) LOCAL REFERENDUM. A district may not take any action under s. 229.68 (4)
6 unless the electors within the jurisdiction approve of the creation of the district in
7 a referendum called by each of the county boards of the counties within the district’s
8 jurisdiction for that purpose at the next spring primary or election or September
9 primary or general election, to be held not sooner than 45 days after the referendum
10 is called by the county board. Each county board shall call for a referendum under
11 this subsection, for the same election, not later than 90 days after the effective date
12 of this subsection [revisor inserts date]. The referendum question shall be: “Do
13 you approve of the creation of a Professional Baseball Park District by the state
14 legislature, the jurisdiction of which includes [name of county]?”. If the question is
15 approved by a majority of all votes cast on the question at that election, the district
