1	AN ACT to create 938.396 (2m) (c) of the statutes; relating to: disclosure of
2	certain information concerning a juvenile who has been adjudicated delinquent
3	for committing a violation that would be a serious felony if committed by an
4	adult.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
5	SECTION 1. 938.396 (2m) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
6	938.396 (2m) (c) Notwithstanding sub. (2), upon request, a court shall disclose
7	to the requester the name and age of a juvenile who has been adjudicated delinquent
8	for committing a violation that would be a serious felony, as defined in s. 939.62 (2m)
9	(a) 1. to 3., if committed by an adult, other than a violation of s. $940.09(1)$ (bm), 948.05
10	(2) or 948.06 (2) or a violation of s. 948.07 (1) with intent to commit a violation of s.
11	948.095. In addition, the court shall disclose to the requester the nature of the
12	violation committed by the juvenile and the disposition imposed on the juvenile as

a result of the violation. The requester may further disclose the information to
anyone.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

4 (1) This act first applies to juveniles who are adjudicated delinquent on the5 effective date of this subsection.
