**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 232**

March 10, 1998 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE AND ENVIRONMENTAL  
RESOURCES.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 95.21 (2) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** rabies vaccination of  
2           dogs.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do  
enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 95.21 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

4           95.21 (2) (a) *Requirement for vaccination.* Except as provided in s. 174.054, the  
5     owner of a dog shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian ~~within~~  
6     ~~30 days after the dog reaches 4~~ at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated  
7     within one year after the initial vaccination. If the owner obtains the dog or brings  
8     the dog into this state after the dog has reached ~~4~~ 5 months of age, the owner shall  
9     have the dog vaccinated against rabies within 30 days after the dog is obtained or  
10    brought into the state unless the dog has been vaccinated as evidenced by a current  
11    certificate of rabies vaccination from this state or another state. The owner of a dog  
12    shall have the dog revaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian before the date that

1 the immunization expires as stated on the certificate of vaccination or, if no date is  
2 specified, within 3 years after the previous vaccination.
