## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- SECTION 1. 252.15 (7) (c) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

  5 252.15 (7) (c) (intro.) A Except as provided in sub. (7m), a report made under

  6 par. (b) may not include any of the following:
  - **Section 2.** 252.15 (7m) of the statutes is created to read:
  - 252.15 (7m) Reporting of Persons significantly exposed. If a positive, validated test result is obtained from a test subject, the test subject's physician who maintains a record of the test result under sub. (4) (c) may report to the state epidemiologist the name of any person known to the physician to have been

- significantly exposed to the test subject, only after the physician has done all of the following:
  - (a) Counseled the test subject to inform any person who has been significantly exposed to the test subject.
  - (b) Notified the test subject that the name of any person known to the physician to have been significantly exposed to the test subject will be reported to the state epidemiologist.
