- (1) Funding of Certain employer contributions for county jailers. From January 1, 1999, to December 31, 1999, the state, from the appropriation under section 20.515 (1) (ag) of the statutes, as created by this act, shall pay, for any county government that is an employer under the Wisconsin retirement system, any increase in employer contributions under section 40.05 (2) (a) of the statutes during that period that results from granting county jailers protective occupation participant status under this act.
- (2) Retirement research committee study. The retirement research committee is requested to study alternative funding mechanisms to pay for the increased employer cost that results from providing county jailers protective occupation status under the Wisconsin retirement system. If the retirement research committee conducts the study, the retirement research committee shall submit its report to the joint survey committee on retirement systems by January 1, 1999.".
