ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 362

March 24, 1998 - Offered by Representative F. LASEE.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	${f 1.}$ Page 1, line 4: after "system" insert "and creating an individual income tax
3	deduction for insurance costs paid by certain county jailers".
4	2. Page 3, line 13: before that line insert:
5	"SECTION 1e. 40.05 (1) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
6	40.05 (1) (c) Unless otherwise provided in a collective bargaining agreement
7	entered into under subch. IV of ch. 111, any participating employe who is granted
8	protective occupation participant status under 1997 Wisconsin Act (this act) shall
9	pay his or her portion of any increased cost that his or her employer would have to
10	pay under sub. (2) (a) and (ar), as a result of having protective occupation participant
11	status, as an employe contribution under this subsection. This amount shall be in
12	addition to any amount paid under par. (a).".
13	3. Page 3, line 18: after that line insert:

1 "SECTION 4e. 71.05 (6) (b) 27. of the statutes is created to read:

71.05 (6) (b) 27. Any amount paid by a participating employe for the increased
insurance costs that are described under s. 40.05 (1) (c) that relate to the employe
having protective occupation participant status, as described in that paragraph.

SECTION 4m. Initial applicability.

6 (1) The treatment of section 40.05 (1) (c) of the statutes first applies to county 7 jailers who are affected by a collective bargaining agreement that contains 8 provisions inconsistent with section 40.05 (1) (c) of the statutes, as created by this 9 act, on the day on which the collective bargaining agreement expires or on the day 10 on which the collective bargaining agreement is extended, modified or renewed, 11 whichever first occurs.

(2) The treatment of section 71.05 (6) (b) 27. of the statutes first applies to
taxable years beginning on January 1 of the year in which a collective bargaining
agreement that applies to county jailers and that contains provisions inconsistent
with section 40.05 (1) (c) of the statutes, as created by this act, expires or on the day
on which the collective bargaining agreement is extended, modified or renewed,
whichever first occurs.".
