



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 443**

March 10, 1998 – Offered by Representative HUBLER.

1      **AN ACT** *to create* 757.69 (1) (p) of the statutes; **relating to:** the powers of  
2      full-time court commissioners.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3      **SECTION 1.** 757.69 (1) (p) of the statutes is created to read:

4      757.69 (1) (p) If a full-time court commissioner, impose a sentence or place a  
5      defendant on probation in misdemeanor cases if there is a stipulation between the  
6      state and the defendant. An action of a court commissioner under this paragraph is  
7      subject to review by a judge if the state or the defendant moves for review of the action  
8      within 15 days after that action.

9      **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

10     (1) This act first applies to violations committed on the effective date of this  
11     subsection.
