## SENATE AMENDMENT 5, TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 463

May 1, 1998 – Offered by Senators Darling, Rosenzweig, Panzer and Roessler.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 4, line 2: after "degree" insert "and priority for pregnant women for
3	private treatment for alcohol or other drug abuse".
4	<b>2.</b> Page 129, line 23: after that line insert:
5	"SECTION 308m. 51.46 of the statutes is created to read:
6	51.46 Priority for pregnant women for private treatment for alcohol
7	or other drug abuse. For inpatient or outpatient treatment for alcohol or other
8	drug abuse, the first priority for services that are available to privately paying
9	patients in privately operated facilities, whether on a voluntary or involuntary basis,
10	is for pregnant women who suffer from alcoholism, alcohol abuse or drug
11	dependency.".
12	<b>3.</b> Page 134, line 11: after "(1)" insert "GENERAL APPLICABILITY.".

13 **4.** Page 134, line 20: after that line insert:

1 "(2t) PRIORITY FOR PREGNANT WOMEN FOR PRIVATE TREATMENT FOR ALCOHOL OR 2 OTHER DRUG ABUSE. The treatment of section 51.46 of the statutes first applies to 3 applications for voluntary admission that are submitted and emergency detentions 4 and involuntary commitments that are made on the effective date of this 5 subsection.".
