ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 50

September 30, 1997 - Offered by Representative Musser.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 4: delete lines 4 to 10 and substitute "age. No person who is under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle which is an implement of husbandry that is not a small all-terrain vehicle on a roadway or on a shoulder of a roadway under any circumstances. No person who is under 12 years of age may operate an a small all-terrain vehicle on a roadway under the authorization provided under sub. (4) (d) 6. under any circumstances or a shoulder of a roadway except to cross the roadway in the manner required under sub. (4) (d) 1. if the crossing is part of an all-terrain vehicle trail or all-terrain vehicle route and the person is accompanied by his or parent or guardian or by another person if that other person is at least 21 years of age. No person who is under 12 years of age may rent or lease an all-terrain vehicle. For purposes of this paragraph, supervision does not require

- that the person under 12 years of age be subject to continuous direction or control by
- the person over 18 years of age.".
