1	$AN \ ACT \textit{ to amend } 29.092\ (3)\ (g) \ and \ 29.145\ (1c)\ (c); \ and \textit{ to create } 29.145\ (1cm)$
2	of the statutes; relating to: fishing licenses for disabled veterans.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 29.092 (3) (g) of the statutes, as created by 1997 Wisconsin Act 1,
4	is amended to read:
5	29.092 (3) (g) Resident disabled veteran. The fee for an annual fishing license
6	issued to a resident disabled veteran under s. 29.145 (1c) (c) is 4.25 <u>2.25</u> .
7	SECTION 2. 29.145 (1c) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	29.145 (1c) (c) Produces evidence that shows that he or she is a veteran, as
9	defined in 38 USC 101, and is receiving disability compensation benefits under 38
10	USC 301 to 363 1101 to 1163 for a reduction in earning capacity disabilities that
11	result in a disability rating that is rated greater than 70% <u>or greater</u> under 38 USC
12	355 <u>1114</u> .

SECTION 3. 29.145 (1cm) of the statutes is created to read: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ 29.145 (1cm) FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS. If the department determines that the fee collected for an annual fishing license issued under sub. (1c) (c) is less or more 3 than is necessary to qualify these licenses for matching funding under 16 USC 777c, 4 $\mathbf{5}$ the department shall submit proposed legislation to the legislature in the manner provided under s. 13.172. (2) to adjust the fee so that is equals the minimum amount 6 $\mathbf{7}$ necessary to qualify for the matching funding. 8 **SECTION 4. Initial applicability.**
