



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 6,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 105**

March 2, 1999 – Offered by Representative MILLER.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2           **1.** Page 4, line 8: delete lines 8 to 11 and substitute “appeal board for  
3           permission to hold a special referendum submitting a specified question on a date  
4           specified in the petition. If the referendum appeal board finds, within 10 days after  
5           receipt of a petition under this subsection, and with the concurrence of at least 3  
6           members, that no emergency”.

7           **2.** Page 4, line 15: delete the material beginning with “permit” and ending with  
8           “unit.” on line 17 and substitute “disapprove the scheduling of a referendum relating  
9           to the question specified in the petition on the date specified in the petition. If the  
10          referendum appeal board does not so find, within 10 days after receipt of a petition  
11          under this subsection, and with the concurrence of at least 3 members, the local  
12          governmental unit may hold the special referendum on the date specified in the  
13          petition.”.

1           **3.** Page 5, line 9: delete the material beginning with “the governor” and ending  
2 with “persons.” on line 11, and substitute “4 members appointed by the elections  
3 board, including one individual designated by each of the following: the senate  
4 majority leader, the senate minority leader, the speaker of the assembly and the  
5 assembly minority leader. In case of an absence or temporary vacancy, the officer  
6 designating that member may serve as a member of the board.”.
