## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 175

March 28, 2000 - Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1	AN ACT to amend 30.62 (3) (a); and to create 30.62 (3) (c) of the statutes;
2	relating to: requiring that personal flotation devices be worn by certain
3	underaged persons in certain boats.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 30.62 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	30.62 (3) (a) Every boat, except a sailboard and except as provided in <del>par. (b)</del>
6	pars. (b) and (c), shall carry at least one personal flotation device prescribed by
7	federal regulations for each person on board or being attended by the boat, so placed
8	as to be readily accessible and available to the persons.
9	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 30.62 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
10	30.62 (3) (c) No person may operate a boat that is less than 26 feet in length,
11	that is being driven by a motor of more than 25 horsepower and that is under way
12	unless each person on the boat who is 12 years of age or under is wearing a personal
