ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 324

November 9, 1999 - Offered by Representative WALKER.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 8, line 10: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 12m. 253.09 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
4	253.09 (5) A person who is adversely affected by, or who reasonably may be
5	expected to be adversely affected by, conduct that is in violation of this section may
6	bring a civil action for injunctive relief, including reinstatement, damages, including
7	damages for emotional or psychological distress, or both injunctive relief and
8	damages. In an action under this subsection, the court shall award reasonable
9	attorney fees, notwithstanding s. 814.04 (1), to a person who obtains injunctive relief,
10	an award of damages or both.".
11	2. Page 12, line 19: after "(3)" insert "(a)".

12 **3.** Page 12, line 24: after that line insert:

"(b) A person who is adversely affected by, or who reasonably may be expected
to be adversely affected by, conduct that is in violation of par. (a) may bring a civil
action for injunctive relief, including reinstatement, damages, including damages
for emotional or psychological distress, or both injunctive relief and damages. In an
action under this paragraph, the court shall award reasonable attorney fees,
notwithstanding s. 814.04 (1), to a person who obtains injunctive relief, an award of
damages or both.".
