**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 465**

September 22, 1999 – Offered by Representatives LASSA, KRUG, COGGS, SCHNEIDER,  
RICHARDS, BOCK, MILLER, SINICKI, BALOW, BERCEAU, MORRIS-TATUM and RILEY.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2           **1.** Page 22, line 6: before that line insert:

3           “**SECTION 12g.** 20.433 (1) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

4           20.433 (1) (c) *Child abuse and neglect prevention grants.* A sum sufficient equal  
5           to 0.5% of the total amounts appropriated and estimated to be expended from all  
6           sources for the department of corrections for each fiscal year as shown in the schedule  
7           under s. 20.005 (3), to be used for grants to organizations under s. 48.982 (4), (6) and  
8           (7) and for statewide projects under s. 48.982 (5).

9           **SECTION 12r.** 20.435 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

10           20.435 (3) (b) *Child abuse and neglect prevention grants and projects.* A sum  
11           sufficient equal to 0.5% of the total amounts appropriated and estimated to be  
12           expended from all sources for the department of corrections for each fiscal year as  
13           shown in the schedule under s. 20.005 (3), to be used for grants to programs and

1 statewide projects the primary goal of which is the prevention of child abuse and  
2 neglect.”.

3 **2.** Page 25, line 15: after that line insert:

4 “**SECTION 27j.** 46.03 (7) (f) of the statutes is repealed.

5 **SECTION 27m.** 46.03 (7) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

6 46.03 (7) (g) In consultation with the child abuse and neglect prevention board,  
7 develop a plan for the expenditure of funds from the appropriation account under s.  
8 20.435 (3) (b). The plan shall ensure that funds from the appropriation account  
9 under s. 20.435 (3) (b) are not used to supplant any other funding the department  
10 provides for the prevention of child abuse and neglect. Beginning in 2000, by June  
11 30 of each year the department shall submit a copy of the plan for the next fiscal year  
12 to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature, for distribution to the appropriate  
13 standing committees under s. 13.172 (3).”.

14 **3.** Page 27, line 12: after that line insert:

15 “**SECTION 35e.** 48.982 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

16 48.982 (4) (a) From the appropriations under s. 20.433 (1) (c), (h), (i), (k), (m)  
17 and (q), the board shall award grants to organizations in accordance with the plan  
18 developed under sub. (2) (a). In each of the first 2 fiscal years in which grants are  
19 awarded, no organization may receive a grant or grants totaling more than \$30,000.

20 **SECTION 35f.** 48.982 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

21 48.982 (5) STATEWIDE PROJECTS. From the appropriations under s. 20.433 (1) (c),  
22 (i) and (r), the board shall administer any statewide project for which it has accepted  
23 money under sub. (2m) (c).

24 **SECTION 35g.** 48.982 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
