## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 550

November 10, 1999 - Offered by Representative GUNDRUM.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 3, line 23: delete lines 23 and 24 and substitute:
3	"(3) A person who violates sub. (2) is guilty of a Class B felony.
4	<b>SECTION 3g.</b> 941.39 (3) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act (this
5	act), is amended to read:
6	941.39 (3) A person who violates sub. (2) is guilty of a Class $\underline{B} \underline{C}$ felony.".
7	<b>2.</b> Page 4, line 19: delete lines 19 and 20 and substitute:
8	"(3) A person who violates sub. (2) is guilty of a Class B felony.
9	<b>SECTION 4g.</b> 941.40 (3) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act (this
10	act), is amended to read:
11	941.40 (3) A person who violates sub. (2) is guilty of a Class $\mathbb{B} \underline{C}$ felony.".
12	SECTION 4m. Nonstatutory provisions.

1999 – 2000 Legislature – 2 –

1	(1q) Reconciliation provision. The amendment of sections $941.39$ (3) and
2	$941.40\ (3)$ of the statutes, as created by this act, and Section 6s (1g), (2h) and (3i) of
3	this act are void unless the treatment of section 939.50 (3) (c) of the statutes by 1999
4	Assembly Bill 465 is enacted into law before July 1, 2000, in exactly the same form
5	as it appears in section 240 of 1999 Assembly Bill 465, as passed by the assembly.".
6	<b>3.</b> Page 4, line 22: delete "treatment" and substitute "creation".
7	<b>4.</b> Page 4, line 24: after that line insert:
8	"(1r) Transfer or use of syringe, needle or other device; reconciled
9	PROVISION. The amendment of section 941.39 (3) of the statutes first applies to
10	offenses committed on the effective date of this subsection.".
11	<b>5.</b> Page 5, line 1: delete "treatment" and substitute "creation".
12	<b>6.</b> Page 5, line 3: after that line insert:
13	"(2r) Sexual intercourse or sexual contact; reconciled provision. The
14	amendment of section 941.40 $(3)$ of the statutes first applies to offenses committed
15	on the effective date of this subsection.
16	SECTION 6s. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication,
17	except as follows:
18	(1g) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 has been enacted on or before the day after
19	publication of this act and the day after publication of this act is on or before
20	December 31, 1999, the amendment of sections 941.39 (3) and 941.40 (3) of the
21	statutes and SECTION 5 (1r) and (2r) of this act take effect on December 31, 1999.
22	(2h) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 has been enacted on or before the day after
23	publication of this act and the day after publication of this act is after December 31,

1 1999, the amendment of sections 941.39 (3) and 941.40 (3) and SECTION 5 (1r) and (2r)
 2 of this act take effect on the day after publication of this act.

3 (3i) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 is enacted after the day after publication of this
4 act but before July 1, 2000, the amendment of sections 941.39 (3) and 941.40 (3) and
5 SECTION 5 (1r) and (2r) of this act take effect on December 31, 1999, or on the date
6 that the treatment of section 939.50 (3) (c) of the statutes by 1999 Assembly Bill 465
7 takes effect, whichever is later.".
