ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 688

March 1, 2000 - Offered by Representative STONE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 9: delete lines 9 to 12 and substitute:

3 "(bm) Paragraph (a) does not apply to the confidential exchange of information between an agency and another social welfare agency, a law enforcement agency, a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ public school or a private school regarding an individual in the care or legal custody 6 of the agency. A social welfare agency that obtains information under this paragraph 7 shall keep the information confidential as required under this section and s. 938.78. A law enforcement agency that obtains information under this paragraph shall keep 8 9 the information confidential as required under ss. 48.396 (1) and 938.396 (1). A public school that obtains information under this paragraph shall keep the 10 11 information confidential as required under s. 118.125 and a private school that 12obtains information under this paragraph shall keep the information confidential in the same manner as is required of a public school under s. 118.125.". 13

2. Page 3, line 6: delete lines 6 to 9 and substitute:

 $\mathbf{2}$ "(bm) Paragraph (a) does not apply to the confidential exchange of information 3 between an agency and another social welfare agency, a law enforcement agency, the victim-witness coordinator, a fire investigator under s. 165.55 (15), a public school 4 5 or a private school regarding an individual in the care or legal custody of the agency. 6 A social welfare agency that obtains information under this paragraph shall keep the $\mathbf{7}$ information confidential as required under this section and s. 48.78. A law 8 enforcement agency that obtains information under this paragraph shall keep the 9 information confidential as required under ss. 48.396 (1) and 938.396 (1). A public school that obtains information under this paragraph shall keep the information 10 11 confidential as required under s. 118.125 and a private school that obtains 12information under this paragraph shall keep the information confidential in the 13same manner as is required of a public school under s. 118.125.".
