**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 808**

March 28, 2000 - Offered by Representative KLUSMAN.

1 **AN ACT to renumber** 146.345 (1) (a); **to amend** 146.345 (title), 146.345 (1) (b),
2 146.345 (1) (c) and 146.345 (2); and **to create** 146.345 (1) (ag) of the statutes;
3 **relating to:** prohibitions relating to human fetal tissue.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 146.345 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 **146.345 (title) Sale of human organs and human fetal tissue prohibited.**

6 **SECTION 2.** 146.345 (1) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 146.345 (1) (am).

7 **SECTION 3.** 146.345 (1) (ag) of the statutes is created to read:

8 146.345 (1) (ag) "Human fetal tissue" means tissue or cells obtained from a
9 dead human embryo or fetus after a spontaneous or induced abortion or a stillbirth.

10 **SECTION 4.** 146.345 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

11 146.345 (1) (b) "~~Human organ transplantation~~ Transplantation" means the
12 medical procedure by which transfer of a human organ is made from the body of a

1 person to the body of another person or by which transfer of human fetal tissue is
2 made to the body of a person.

3 **SECTION 5.** 146.345 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 146.345 (1) (c) "Valuable consideration" does not include ~~reasonable payment~~
5 actual and necessary costs associated with the removal, transportation,
6 implantation, processing, preservation, quality control or storage of a human organ
7 ~~or; an expense of travel, housing or lost wages incurred by a human organ donor in~~
8 ~~connection with donation of the human organ; or the transportation, implantation,~~
9 processing, preservation, quality control or storage of human fetal tissue.

10 **SECTION 6.** 146.345 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

11 146.345 (2) No person may knowingly and for valuable consideration acquire,
12 receive or otherwise transfer any human organ for use in ~~human-organ~~
13 transplantation or any human fetal tissue.
