



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 SENATE BILL 106**

March 7, 2000 – Offered by Senators MOORE and WIRCH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 7, line 23: after “proceeding.” insert “If a court-appointed special
3 advocate discloses information in violation of the confidentiality requirement
4 specified in this paragraph, the court-appointed special advocate is liable to any
5 person damaged as a result of that disclosure for such damages as may be proved and,
6 notwithstanding s. 814.04 (1), for such costs and reasonable actual attorney fees as
7 may be incurred by the person damaged.”.

8 **2.** Page 8, line 15: after “proceeding.” insert “If a court-appointed special
9 advocate discloses information in violation of the confidentiality requirement
10 specified in this paragraph, the court-appointed special advocate is liable to any
11 person damaged as a result of that disclosure for such damages as may be proved and,

1 notwithstanding s. 814.04 (1), for such costs and reasonable actual attorney fees as
2 may be incurred by the person damaged.”.
