5	in subd. 2., no person may smoke in the state capitol building or on the state capitol
6	grounds.
7	2. Subdivision 1. does not apply to the governor's office, any office space that
8	is assigned to a state senator or state representative to the assembly or any room that
9	is kept by the attorney general, lieutenant governor or supreme court.
10	<b>Section 3g.</b> 101.123 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
11	101.123 (4) (a) 1. Except as provided in subd. subds. 2. and 2m., a person in

charge or his or her agent may designate smoking areas in the places where smoking

is regulated under sub. (2) (a) unless a fire marshal, law, ordinance or resolution prohibits smoking.

**SECTION 3r.** 101.123 (4) (a) 2m. of the statutes is created to read:

101.123 (4) (a) 2m. A person in charge or his or her agent may not designate the entire state capitol building as a smoking area or designate any area where smoking is prohibited in the state capitol building under sub. (2) (ar) 1. as a smoking area.".
