	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 43.24 (2) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	43.24 (2) (e) In-service training for and professional consultation with
8	participating public library personnel and trustees.
9	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 43.24 (2) (f) of the statutes is repealed.
10	<b>SECTION 3.</b> 43.24 (2) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:
11	43.24 (2) (h) Professional consultant services to participating public libraries
12	and counties as evidenced by a written plan and a service program.

1	SECTION 4. 43.24 (2) (j) of the statutes is repealed.
2	<b>SECTION 5.</b> $43.24(2)(L)$ of the statutes is amended to read:
3	43.24 (2) (L) Cooperation and continuous planning with other types of libraries
4	in the system area, which results in agreements with those libraries for the
5	appropriate sharing of library resources to benefit the clientele of all libraries in the
6	system area and a written plan for furthering cooperative activities among all types
7	of libraries.
8	<b>SECTION 6.</b> $43.24(2)(m)$ of the statutes is amended to read:
9	43.24 (2) (m) Continuous planning Planning with the division and with
10	participating public libraries and <del>counties</del> other types of libraries in the area in
11	regard to the library automation and technical services as evidenced by a written
12	<del>plan</del> <u>technology</u> and the sharing of resources. By January 1, 2000, and by every 5th
13	January 1 thereafter, the public library system shall submit to the division a written
14	<u>plan for library technology and the sharing of resources</u> .
