**SENATE AMENDMENT 3,  
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 110**

May 8, 2001 – Offered by Senators HUELSMAN, ROSENZWEIG, LAZICH, DARLING,  
FARROW, ZIEN and PANZER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 33, line 4: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
3 page 34, line 14, and substitute:

4 “(1m) UNIVERSAL, CENTRALIZED VOTER REGISTRATION. The elections board shall  
5 prepare recommendations with regard to requiring voter registration in every  
6 municipality in this state and maintaining a statewide voter registration list. The  
7 recommendations shall address issues relating to the privacy of each elector’s voter  
8 registration information and may not include a recommendation that an elector’s  
9 social security number be recorded on a statewide voter registration list. No later  
10 than 90 days after the effective date of this subsection, the elections board shall  
11 submit the recommendations to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature for

1 distribution to the appropriate standing committees of the legislature in the manner  
2 provided under section 13.172 (3) of the statutes.”.
