| 6 | <u>8,000 or more</u> , from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. |
| 7 | SECTION 23a. 6.78 (2) of the statutes is amended to read: |
| 8 | 6.78 (2) In 4th class cities, villages and towns other municipalities, from 9 a.m. |
| 9 | until 8 p.m.; extendable by the governing body to not earlier than 7 a.m. Notice of |
| 10 | the change of hours shall be given by publication in a newspaper, under ch. 985, once |
| 11 | each week for 2 successive weeks, with the first insertion not less than 8 days before |
| 12 | the election. The new hours shall take effect only after the notice provisions have |

been complied with. When the ordinance applies to all future elections, notice need
be given only for the first election affected by the change.".".
