



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 61**

June 4, 2003 – Offered by Senators LEIBHAM and JAUCH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 11: delete lines 11 to 15 and substitute:

3 “e. Relaying messages regarding wireless emergency 911 telephone calls via
4 data communications from the wireless public safety answering point to local
5 government emergency call centers in operation before June 1, 2003, that dispatch
6 the appropriate emergency service providers, but only if the rules promulgated
7 under par. (d) 4. allow for reimbursement of such costs.”

8 **2.** Page 10, line 3: after that line insert:

9 “4m. The rules promulgated under subd. 4. may allow local governments to
10 receive grants for reimbursement of the costs described in par. (c) 1. e., but only if the
11 commission collects information regarding the expected amount of such costs and the
12 commission determines that the expected amount of the costs is not a significant

1 portion of the overall cost of the statewide system for responding to wireless
2 emergency 911 telephone costs and that reimbursement of such costs is in the public
3 interest, promotes public health and safety, and is not an impediment to
4 consolidation of dispatch functions by local government emergency call centers. If
5 the rules promulgated under subd. 4. allow for reimbursement of the costs described
6 in par. (c) 1. e., the commission shall include the information that the commission is
7 required to collect under this subdivision in the report required for the rules under
8 s. 227.19 (3).”.
