## SENATE AMENDMENT 6, TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 655

January 20, 2004 – Offered by Senators Wirch, Hansen, Chvala, Moore, Coggs, Carpenter, M. Meyer, Decker, Erpenbach, Risser, Jauch, Breske, Robson and Lassa.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2	amendment 2, as follows:
3	${f 1.}$ Page 3, line 10: delete "and granting rule–making authority" and substitute
4	"increasing funding for local youth apprenticeship grants and increasing positions
5	for the Governor's Work–Based Learning Board; granting rule–making authority;
6	and making appropriations".
7	<b>2.</b> Page 3, line 11: delete that line and substitute:
8	"Section 1d. $20.445(1)(e)$ of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act
9	33, is renumbered 20.445 (7) (b).
10	<b>SECTION 1t.</b> 29.601 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:".
11	<b>3.</b> Page 53, line 10: after that line insert:

20	development under section 20.445 $(1)$ $(a)$ of the statutes, as affected by the acts of
