**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2003 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 71**

March 2, 2004 - Offered by Representatives FREESE, GARD and GIELOW.

1     **Relating to:** the policy of the U.S. food and drug administration of not allowing  
2           individuals and pharmacies in the United States to import and re-import  
3           prescription medications purchased in other countries that have regulatory  
4           safeguards for the manufacture and distribution of drugs as strict as the  
5           regulatory safeguards in the United States.

6           *Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That* the Wisconsin state  
7           legislature encourages the U.S. food and drug administration to find a safe and legal  
8           way to allow the importation and reimportation of prescription medications, such as  
9           allowing licensed pharmacies and distributors in the United States to import  
10          medications purchased through safe and legal channels from countries that have  
11          regulatory safeguards for the manufacture and distribution of drugs as strict as the  
12          regulatory safeguards in the United States.
