SENATE AMENDMENT 32, TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2, TO 2003 SENATE BILL 214

October 23, 2003 – Offered by Senator ERPENBACH.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 12, line 14: delete "OR AUTHORIZATION" and substitute "; NOTICE IN
3	DWELLINGS".
4	2. Page 12, line 16: after "(c)" insert ", 943.14,".
5	3. Page 12, line 23: after that line insert:
6	"(d) If a licensee or out-of-state licensee is carrying a concealed weapon in a
7	dwelling that he or she does not own or legally occupy, the licensee or out-of-state
8	licensee shall notify the owner or occupant of the dwelling.".
9	4. Page 39, line 13: after that line insert:
10	"(am) Any person who violates sub. (2g) (d) may be required to forfeit not more
11	than \$1,000.".
12	5. Page 49, line 18: delete lines 18 to 23.

1	6. Page 50, line 1: delete lines 1 to 9.
2	7. Page 50, line 10: delete "2." and substitute "943.13 (1m) (c)".
3	8. Page 50, line 15: delete "subdivision" and substitute "paragraph".
4	9. Page 51, line 10: delete "(c) 2." and substitute "(c)".
5	10. Page 51, line 22: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 53g. 943.14 of the statutes is renumbered 943.14 (1).
7	SECTION 53k. 943.14 (2) of the statutes is created to read:
8	943.14 (2) No individual may intentionally enter or remain in the dwelling of
9	another without the consent of some person lawfully upon the premises after having
10	told the person that he or she is going armed with a concealed and dangerous weapon.
11	A person who violates this prohibition is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.".
