**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 141**

May 12, 2005 – Offered by Representatives SUDER, MUSSER and PETTIS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 9: delete the material beginning with “allowing” and ending
3 with “158” on line 12 and substitute “described in s. 125.032 (1), for the duration of
4 the waiver or pilot program”.

5 **2.** Page 2, line 14: delete “**publication of**” and substitute “**to petition for**
6 **and publish**”.

7 **3.** Page 2, line 15: after “**age.**” insert “**(1)** The department, in consultation
8 with the department of transportation, shall petition the applicable agency of the
9 U.S. government for a waiver of, or for participation in a federal pilot program, if any
10 exists, providing an exception to, the provisions of 23 USC 158 under which this state
11 is authorized to lower the legal drinking age for members of the U.S. armed forces
12 residing in this state to 19 years of age without subjecting this state to withholding
13 of federal highway aid as specified in 23 USC 158. If, within 60 days after the date

1 that the petition is made, the applicable federal agency has not notified the
2 department of its decision on the petition, the department shall consider the petition
3 to be approved and, for purposes of sub. (2) and s. 125.02 (8m) (b), a federal waiver
4 or pilot program participation is considered to be obtained in accordance with the
5 terms of the petition.

6 (2)".

7 4. Page 2, line 16: delete "s. 125.02 (8m) (b)" and substitute "sub. (1)".

8 5. Page 4, line 5: after that line insert:

9 "SECTION 7m. Nonstatutory provisions.

10 (1) The petition under section 125.032 (1) of the statutes, as created by this act,
11 shall be in writing and made in accordance with any procedures required by the
12 applicable federal agency. The petition shall be made within 30 days of the effective
13 date of this subsection."
