## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 602

February 2, 2006 – Offered by Committee on Rural Affairs and Renewable Energy.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	${f 1.}$ Page 1, line 2: after "trespassing" insert "and creating civil immunity for the
3	injury or death of an assessor or a member of an assessor's staff.".
4	<b>2.</b> Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:
5	"SECTION 1g. 893.488 of the statutes is created to read:
6	893.488 Civil liability exemption; owner or person in lawful possession
7	of the premises. (1) In this section:
8	(a) "Construction site" has the meaning given in s. 943.15 (2) (a).
9	(b) "Owner or person in lawful possession of the premises" has the meaning
10	given in s. 943.15 (2) (b)
11	(2) The owner or person in lawful possession of the premises and his or her
12	employees are immune from civil liability for the injury or death of an assessor or a
13	member of the staff of an assessor who enters onto a construction site without the

permission of the owner or person in lawful possession of the premises or his or her
 employee to make an assessment on behalf of the state or a political subdivision.

3 (3) The immunity under this section does not apply if the injury or death
4 resulted from the reckless, wanton, or intentional misconduct of the owner or person
5 in lawful possession of the premises or his or her employee.".
