



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 11,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 6**

February 15, 2005 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the resolution as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 21: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 11m.** Assembly rule 98m is created to read:

4 **ASSEMBLY RULE 98m. Campaign contributions before budget.** (1) In this
5 rule:

6 (a) “Contribution,” “legislative campaign committee,” and “personal campaign
7 committee” have the meanings given for the terms in section 11.01 of the statutes.

8 (b) “Legislative leader” means a member of the assembly committee on
9 organization or the assembly committee on finance.

10 (2) A legislative leader or member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit,
11 make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize a legislative campaign
12 committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for
13 or at; and a legislative leader or member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit,

1 make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize his or her personal campaign
2 committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for
3 or at; a fund-raising social event or otherwise after January 1 of the odd-numbered
4 year and before the date of enactment, as defined in section 35.095 (1) (a) of the
5 statutes, of the executive budget bill introduced under section 16.47 (1) of the
6 statutes.

7 (3) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a legislative
8 campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for
9 filing nomination papers for any special election to the assembly and the date of the
10 special election.

11 (4) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current
12 member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the
13 period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office for
14 which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election
15 for that office, if the event is held within the boundaries of the jurisdiction or district
16 served by the office for which the current member of the assembly is a candidate.

17 (5) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current
18 member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the
19 period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office,
20 other than representative to the assembly, in the case of a member of the assembly,
21 for which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election
22 for that other office.”.
