**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 258**

November 8, 2005 - Offered by Senator REYNOLDS.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 43.17 (12) of the statutes; **relating to:** public library loaning  
2 or rental to minors of movies with a restricted rating.

---

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This substitute amendment provides that a public library must require each applicant for a borrower's card to state whether he or she allows his or her minor children to borrow or rent "R"-rated (restricted) movies. If the parent does not consent, the public library may not loan or rent such movies to those children.

---

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 **SECTION 1.** 43.17 (12) of the statutes is created to read:  
4 43.17 (12) A public library shall require each applicant for a borrower's card  
5 to state whether he or she allows his or her minor children, if any, to borrow or rent  
6 movies rated "restricted" under the rating system instituted by the Motion Picture  
7 Association of America. If the parent or guardian does not consent, the public library  
8 may not loan or rent such movies to those minor children.
