## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 72

March 13, 2007 - Offered by Representative Albers.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 8: after "service," insert "the collection and disposal of
3	prescription drugs,".
4	<b>2.</b> Page 2, line 24: after that line insert:
5	"SECTION 1r. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place,
6	insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

9	(2) AIR AND WASTE
10	(es) Solid waste management — pre-
11	scription drug collection SEG C \$1,000,000 -0-
12	<b>SECTION 11.</b> 20.370 (2) (es) of the statutes is created to read:

1	20.370 (2) (es) Solid waste management — prescription drug collection. From
<b>2</b>	the recycling fund, as a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule for
3	the collection and disposal of prescription drugs under s. 299.41.".
4	<b>3.</b> Page 3, line 21: after that line insert:
<b>5</b>	"SECTION 4m. 299.41 of the statutes is created to read:
6	<b>299.41 Prescription drug collection and disposal.</b> The department shall
7	expend funds appropriated under s. 20.370 (2) (es) for the collection and proper
8	disposal of unused prescription drugs.".
9	<b>4.</b> Page 10, line 6: delete "\$1,500,000" and substitute "\$500,000".
10	<b>5.</b> Page 11, line 15: after that line insert:
11	"SECTION 9400. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after
12	publication, except as follows:
13	(1) Prescription drug collection. The treatment of sections $20.005$ (3)
14	(schedule), $20.370(2)$ (es) and $299.41$ of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2007, or
15	on the day after publication of the biennial budget act, whichever is later.".
