



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 874**

March 12, 2008 – Offered by Representatives KLEEFISCH and ALBERS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 7: delete “Class G” and substitute “Class I”.

3 **2.** Page 2, line 8: delete lines 8 to 13 and substitute:

4 “**SECTION 3g.** 943.50 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 943.50 (4) (a) A Class A misdemeanor, if the value of the merchandise does not
6 exceed \$2,500 \$1,500.

7 **SECTION 3m.** 943.50 (4) (bf) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 943.50 (4) (bf) A Class I felony, if the value of the merchandise exceeds \$2,500
9 \$1,500 but does not exceed \$5,000 or if the person violates this section with the intent
10 to sell the merchandise on the Internet. It is prima facie evidence that the person
11 intends to sell the merchandise on the Internet if, within 90 days preceding the
12 violation, the person sold the same or similar kind of merchandise on the Internet.”.
