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## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2007 SENATE BILL 473

February 22, 2008 – Offered by Committee on Commerce, Utilities and Rail.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 3, line 12: delete lines 12 and 13 and substitute:
3	"(d) "Metal article" means a manufactured item that consists of metal, is usable
4	for its original intended purpose without processing, repair, or alteration, and is
5	offered for sale for the value of the metal it contains, except that "metal article" does
6	not include antique or collectible articles, including jewelry, coins, silverware, and
7	watches.".
8	${f 2.}$ Page 4, line 19: delete lines 19 to 23 and substitute:
9	"(g) "Scrap metal" means a metal article; metal removed from or obtained by
10	cutting, demolishing, or disassembling a building, structure, or manufactured item;
11	or other metal that is no longer used for its original intended purpose and that can
12	be processed for reuse in a mill, foundry, or other manufacturing facility.".

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1	${f 3.}$ Page 5, line 24: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
2	page 6, line 6 and substitute:
3	"b. A description of the scrap or articles that is consistent with guidelines
4	promulgated by a national recycling industry trade organization.".
5	<b>4.</b> Page 7, line 5: delete lines 5 to 7 and substitute:
6	"3. The name of a contact person at the commercial account who is responsible
7	for the sale of nonferrous scrap, metal articles, or proprietary articles to the scrap
8	metal dealer.".
9	<b>5.</b> Page 7, line 18: delete that line and substitute "2., 4., and 5. and (b) 4. and
10	5. for not less than 2 years after recording it. A scrap metal".
11	<b>6.</b> Page 7, line 21: delete that line and substitute "required under sub. (3) (b)
12	1. to 3. regarding a commercial account for not less than".
