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SENATE AMENDMENT 2, TO 2007 SENATE BILL 523

 - **6.** Page 71, line 9: after "implemented" insert "and considering potential adverse impacts due to changes in temperature and nutrient loadings".
 - **7.** Page 74, line 24: delete the material beginning with "does" and ending with "impacts" on page 75, line 2, and substitute "is without adequate supplies of potable water".
 - **8.** Page 75, line 20: after "basin." insert "The department may not use a lack of hydrological connection to the waters of the Great Lakes basin as a reason to disapprove a proposal.".
