**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 210**

April 2, 2010 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1. Page 4, line 1:** delete lines 1 to 5 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 1m.** 20.435 (5) (co) of the statutes, as affected by 2009 Wisconsin Act  
4 28, is amended to read:

5 20.435 (5) (co) *Integrated service programs for children with severe disabilities*  
6 *Initiatives for coordinated services.* The amounts in the schedule to fund, ~~under s.~~  
7 ~~46.56 (15), county integrated service programs for children with severe disabilities~~  
8 and tribal initiatives under s. 46.56 to provide coordinated services.”.

9 **2. Page 30, line 6:** after “statutes” insert “, as affected by 2009 Wisconsin Act  
10 28,”.

10 **3. Page 37, line 7:** delete lines 7 to 15 and substitute:

11 “**SECTION 72g.** 46.56 (15) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2009 Wisconsin Act  
12 28, is amended to read:

1           46.56 (15) (a) From the appropriation account under s. 20.435 (5) (co), the  
2 department shall make available funds to implement programs initiatives under  
3 this section. ~~The funds may be used to pay for the intake, assessment, case planning~~  
4 ~~and service coordination provided under sub. (8) and for expanding the capacity of~~  
5 ~~the county to provide community-based care and treatment for children with severe~~  
6 ~~disabilities.~~

7           **SECTION 72r.** 46.56 (15) (b) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

8           46.56 (15) (b) (intro.) In order to apply for funds under this section subsection  
9 the county board of supervisors or tribe shall do all of the following:”.

10          **4.** Page 37, line 21: delete “2. to 4.” and substitute “2. and 3.”.

11          **5.** Page 38, line 6: delete lines 6 to 12 and substitute:

12          “**SECTION 74m.** 46.56 (15) (b) 4. of the statutes, as affected by 2009 Wisconsin  
13 Act 28, is amended to read:

14          46.56 (15) (b) 4. Submit a description of the existing services and other  
15 resources in the county or tribe for children with severe disabilities who are involved  
16 in 2 or more systems of care, an assessment of any gaps in services, and a plan for  
17 using the funds received under this program subsection or funds from other funding  
18 sources to develop or expand any needed community-based services such as in-home  
19 ~~treatment, day treatment, respite care, or crisis services~~ the initiative.”.
