**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 276**

April 22, 2010 – Offered by Representative ZIGMUNT.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “sites” insert “and qualifications of newspapers eligible  
to publish legal notices”.

3 **2.** Page 2, line 12: after that line insert:

4 “SECTION 1g. 985.03 (1) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 985.03 (1) (a) (intro.) No publisher of any newspaper in this state shall be  
6 awarded or be entitled to any compensation or fee for the publishing of any legal  
7 notice unless, for at least 2 1 of the 5 years immediately before the date of the notice  
8 publication, the newspaper has been published regularly and continuously in the  
9 city, village or town where published, and has had a bona fide paid circulation:”.
