**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 10,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 40**

June 14, 2011 – Offered by Representatives DANOU, PASCH, RICHARDS, HEBL, POCAN,  
ROYS, SEIDEL, TURNER and YOUNG.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 115, line 2: delete lines 2 and 3.

3 **2.** Page 235, line 7: after that line insert:

4 “(kg) Assistant district attorneys PR-S A 1,000,000 1,000,000”.

5 **3.** Page 253, line 9: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2011-12 by  
6 \$35,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2012-13 by \$35,700 for the  
7 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

8 **4.** Page 309, line 17: after that line insert:

9 “SECTION 493cm. 20.155 (3) (t) of the statutes is repealed.”.

10 **5.** Page 354, line 20: after that line insert:

11 “SECTION 696m. 20.475 (1) (kg) of the statutes is created to read:

1           20.475 (1) (kg) *Assistant district attorneys*. The amounts in the schedule for  
2 salaries and fringe benefits of assistant district attorneys. All moneys transferred  
3 from the appropriation account under s. 20.505 (1) (id) 7. shall be credited to this  
4 appropriation account.”.

18          **13.** Page 482, line 6: delete the material beginning with that line and ending

21 with page 491, line 2.

22          **15.** Page 640, line 3: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
23 with page 641, line 5.

2 with page 653, line 19.

3           **17.** Page 875, line 24: after that line insert:

4           “**SECTION 2181g.** 77.54 (55) of the statutes is repealed.”

5           **18.** Page 886, line 15: delete “accounts under s. 20.835 (1) (q) and (r)” and  
6 substitute “accounts account under s. 20.835 (1) (q) and ~~(r)~~”.

7           **19.** Page 975, line 9: delete lines 9 to 18.

8           **20.** Page 975, line 20: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
9 with page 976, line 20.

10          **21.** Page 985, line 1: delete lines 1 to 15.

11          **22.** Page 1130, line 1: before that line insert:

12          “**SECTION 2707ge.** 196.025 (6) of the statutes is repealed.

13          **SECTION 2707gm.** 196.202 (2) of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin Act  
14 22, is amended to read:

15           196.202 (2) SCOPE OF REGULATION. A commercial mobile radio service provider  
16 is not subject to this chapter, except as provided in sub. (5), and except that a  
17 commercial mobile radio service provider is subject to ss. ~~196.025 (6)~~, 196.218 (3), and  
18 196.859, and shall respond, subject to the protection of the commercial mobile radio  
19 service provider’s competitive information, to all reasonable requests for information  
20 about its operations in this state from the commission necessary to administer ss.  
21 ~~196.025 (6)~~, 196.218 (3), and 196.859.

22          **SECTION 2707gs.** 196.203 (1g) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin  
23 Act 22, is amended to read:

1           196.203 (1g) (a) An alternative telecommunications utility is subject to ss.  
2           196.01, 196.016, ~~196.025 (6)~~, 196.191, 196.206, and 196.212.”.

3           **23.** Page 1132, line 19: after that line insert:

4           “**SECTION 2715m.** 196.499 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

5           196.499 (1) SCOPE. (intro.) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this  
6           chapter, a telecommunications carrier is not subject to regulation under this chapter,  
7           except for s. ~~196.025 (6)~~, and except under each of the following provisions:”.

8           **24.** Page 1217, line 14: delete the material beginning with that line and  
9           ending with page 1218, line 14, and substitute:

10          “**SECTION 3003g.** 301.26 (4) (d) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

11          301.26 (4) (d) 2. Beginning on ~~January~~ July 1, 2010 2011, and ending on June  
12          30, ~~2010 2012~~, the per person daily cost assessment to counties shall be ~~\$270~~ \$243  
13          for care in a Type 1 juvenile correctional facility, as defined in s. 938.02 (19), ~~\$270~~  
14          \$243 for care for juveniles transferred from a juvenile correctional institution under  
15          s. 51.35 (3), ~~\$298~~ \$268 for care in a residential care center for children and youth,  
16          ~~\$190~~ \$171 for care in a group home for children, ~~\$72~~ \$65 for care in a foster home,  
17          ~~\$124~~ \$112 for care in a ~~treatment~~ higher level foster home under rules promulgated  
18          under s. 48.62 (8) (c), ~~\$101~~ as determined by the department, ~~\$91~~ for departmental  
19          corrective sanctions services, and ~~\$40~~ \$36 for departmental aftercare services.

20          **SECTION 3003r.** 301.26 (4) (d) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

21          301.26 (4) (d) 3. Beginning on July 1, ~~2010 2012~~, and ending on June 30, ~~2011~~  
22          2013, the per person daily cost assessment to counties shall be ~~\$275~~ \$248 for care in  
23          a Type 1 juvenile correctional facility, as defined in s. 938.02 (19), ~~\$275~~ \$248 for care  
24          for juveniles transferred from a juvenile correctional institution under s. 51.35 (3),

1     ~~\$313~~ \$282 for care in a residential care center for children and youth, ~~\$200~~ \$180 for  
2     care in a group home for children, ~~\$75~~ \$68 for care in a foster home, ~~\$130~~ \$117 for  
3     care in a ~~treatment~~ higher level foster home under rules promulgated under s. 48.62  
4     (8) (c), ~~\$103~~ as determined by the department, ~~\$93~~ for departmental corrective  
5     sanctions services, and ~~\$41~~ \$37 for departmental aftercare services.”.

7           **26.** Page 1445, line 5: after that line insert:

8           “(3d) ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY SALARIES. The offices of the district attorneys  
9     shall work with the office of state employment relations to allocate the moneys  
10    appropriated under section 20.475 (1) (kg) of the statutes, as created by this act.”.

11          **27.** Page 1496, line 2: delete lines 2 to 19.

12          **28.** Page 1502, line 4: after that line insert:

13          “(1m) POLICE AND FIRE PROTECTION FUND. On the effective date of this subsection,  
14    the unencumbered balance in the police and fire protection fund immediately before  
15    the effective date of this subsection is transferred to the general fund.”.

16          **29.** Page 1514, line 6: delete lines 6 to 9.

17          **30.** Page 1514, line 23: delete the material beginning with that line and  
18    ending with page 1515, line 2.
