ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 476

January 24, 2012 - Offered by Representative TAUCHEN.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 19, line 7: after that line insert:

"Section 26g. 66.0213 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.0213 (4) (b) The election shall be conducted as prescribed by ch. 6, except that no registration of voters may be required. The inspectors shall make returns to the clerk of the circuit court who shall, within one week 14 days after the election, canvass the returns and declare the result. The clerk shall notify the officers-elect and issue certificates of election. If the first election is on the first Tuesday in April the officers elected and their appointees shall commence and hold their offices as for a regular term. Otherwise they shall commence within 10 14 days and hold their offices until the regular village or city election and the qualification of their successors and the terms of their appointees expire as soon as successors qualify.

Section 26r. 66.0215 (9) of the statutes is amended to read:

- the town board and the town clerk who received the petition shall fix a time for the first city election, designate the polling place or places, and name 3 inspectors of election for each place. Ten days' previous notice of the election shall be given by the clerk by publication in the newspapers selected under sub. (3) and by posting notices in 3 public places in the city. Failure to give notice does not invalidate the election. The election shall be conducted as is prescribed by chs. 5 to 12, except that no registration of voters may be required. The inspectors shall make returns to the board which shall, within one week 14 days after the election, canvass the returns and declare the result. The clerk shall notify the officers—elect and issue certificates of election. If the first election is on the first Tuesday in April the officers elected and their appointees commence and hold their offices as for a regular term. Otherwise they commence within 10 14 days and hold until the regular city election and the qualification of their successors, and the term of their appointees expires as soon as successors qualify."
 - **2.** Page 20, line 5: delete lines 5 to 9.
 - **3.** Page 20, line 9: after that line insert:

"Section 29m. Nonstatutory provisions.

- (1) (a) Notwithstanding sections 17.25 (1) and 60.30 (4) (a) of the statutes, any town board of supervisors may enact an ordinance providing that the terms of office of any elective officers in the town who were elected or appointed to serve for terms expiring on the 2nd Tuesday in April of 2012 or 2013 are extended so as to expire on the 3rd Tuesday in April in the same year in which the terms would otherwise expire.
 - (b) Paragraph (a) does not apply after April 16, 2013.".

1	4. Page 20, line 15: after that line insert:
2	"Section 31. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after
3	publication, except as follows:
4	(1) The treatment of sections $60.11(2)$ and $60.16(1)$ of the statutes takes effectively
5	on January 1, 2013.".
