SENATE AMENDMENT 3, TO 2013 SENATE BILL 1

March 4, 2014 – Offered by Senators T. Cullen, L. Taylor, Carpenter, Miller, Lehman, Vinehout, Hansen, C. Larson, Lassa, Risser and Wirch.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 3, line 4: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 1m. 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2011 Wisconsin Act
4	32, is amended to read:
5	20.865 (4) (a) General purpose revenue funds general program
6	supplementation. Biennially, the amounts in the schedule to be used to supplement
7	appropriations of the general fund which prove insufficient because of unforeseen
8	emergencies or which prove insufficient to accomplish the purposes for which made,
9	to be used to award grants to school districts under 2013 Wisconsin Act (this act),
10	section 9124 (1d), to be used to make loans to appropriations from the general or any
11	segregated fund as provided in s. 13.101 (4m) and miscellaneous expense of the joint
12	committee on finance not to exceed \$250. All loans from this appropriation when
13	repaid shall be credited to this appropriation if repaid during the biennium in which

1	the loan is made. All loans from this appropriation not repaid during the biennium
2	in which the loan is made shall be general purpose revenues-earned. The governor
3	may under this paragraph allot sums not in excess of \$1,000 to any department or
4	agency when necessary, without a meeting of the joint committee on finance. All
5	allotments made under this paragraph by the governor shall be certified by him or
6	her to the department of administration, and expenditures therefrom shall be shown
7	in the state budget report as an additional cost of the state agency to which such
8	allotments were made.".
9	2. Page 17, line 9: after that line insert:
10	"SECTION 44m. 2013 Wisconsin Act 20, section 9252 (1) (a) (intro.) is amended
11	to read:
12	[2013 Wisconsin Act 20] Section 9252 (1) (a) (intro.) Notwithstanding 2011
13	Wisconsin Act 32, section 9255 (1) (c) and (d), the secretary shall not lapse any money
14	from the agencies specified in those paragraphs during the 2013–15 fiscal biennium,
15	but shall instead lapse to the general fund from the unencumbered balances of
16	general purpose revenue and program revenue appropriations to the following
17	executive branch state agencies, other than sum sufficient appropriations and
18	appropriations of federal revenues, the following amounts in each fiscal year of the
19	2013–15 fiscal biennium <u>the 2013–14, 2014–15, and 2015–16 fiscal years</u> :
20	SECTION 9124. Nonstatutory provisions; Joint Committee on Finance.
21	(1d) GRANTS TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS. The joint committee on finance shall award
22	grants to school districts during the 2014–15 fiscal year for programs designed to
23	address issues faced by pupils whose lives outside of school are dysfunctional. The
24	programs may consist of after-school classes, summer school classes, or other means

1 of addressing the issues facing these pupils. The committee shall award the grants 2 from the appropriation under section 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes. The total amount 3 of grants awarded in the 2014-15 fiscal year may not exceed \$10,000,000. At the end 4 of the 2014–15 fiscal year, any amount equal to the difference between \$10,000,000 5 and the total amount of grants awarded under this subsection shall be transferred 6 from the appropriation under section 20.865 (4) (a) of the statutes to the general 7 fund.". 8 **3.** Page 17, line 14: after that line insert:

"SECTION 9201. Fiscal changes; Administration.

(1m) TRANSFERS TO THE BUDGET STABILIZATION FUND. Notwithstanding section
16.518 (3) of the statutes, no amounts shall be transferred from the general fund to
the budget stabilization fund during the 2013–15 fiscal biennium.

SECTION 9224. Fiscal changes; Joint Committee on Finance.

(1d) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the
appropriation to the joint committee on finance under section 20.865 (4) (a) of the
statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013, the dollar amount is increased by
\$10,000,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection
takes effect to provide funding for grants to school districts under SECTION 9124 (1d)
of this act.".
